LOCATION

The assembly area is at the intersection of Blackwood Road and Fingerpost Road. Coordinates -37.417, 144.514

Directions: Exit the Calder Freeway (M79) south of Woodend along Black Forest Drive (C792). Head north towards Woodend for approx 2km then turn left on Fingerpost Road and follow signs to junction of Blackwood Rd.

Scale: 1:20,000, 10m Contour Interval.

COURSE SETTER NOTES

This map has a good network of forest roads and singletracks and is a popular mountain biking area. There is a mix of Pine and Eucalypt forest.

COURSES

The table suggests which age classes might ride which courses, but you may choose any other course by entering the 'Open' option for that course. Course 4b is less technical/physically demanding than Course 4.

ENTRIES

All entries are to be made via Eventor. **Entries close on Tuesday 28 April at 11.59pm.**

Entry on the day will be accepted only if there are sufficient maps and will incur a \$5 surcharge.

SportIdent electronic timing will be used for this event. If you do not have an SI card, you can hire one for \$3. Select that 'SportIdent Hire' in the Services menu when entering in Eventor.

ON THE DAY

Registration opens at 10.00 am. The start will be open from 11.00 am to 12.00 noon. Courses close at 2.30 pm. All riders must finish by that time as controls will be brought in from then.
