Travel Directions: From Melbourne: From the M80/M8 Western Highway exit at Gordon, take the road into Gordon, left at cross roads, then right into Gordon –Meredith Rd to Mt Egerton. After passing through Mt Egerton take the Yendon – Egerton Rd, just before railway crossing left into Yendon – Lal Lal Rd to Lal Lal. Straight over into Coalmine Rd, left into Haywards Rd then right onto Mt Doran Rd, follow signs to the assembly area.

N.B. Do not follow Google Maps route over Lal Lal Reservoir dam wall as a No Through Rd.

From Ballarat: Take A300 Midland Hwy to Claredon, left into Claredon – Lal Lal Rd, then right into Coalmine Rd at Lal Lal. Left into Haywards Rd then right onto Mt Doran Rd, follow signs to the assembly area.

From Geelong: Take A300 to Claredon, turn right into Claredon – Lal Lal Rd then as per above.

There will be club toilets at the event. There are public toilets in Gordon or Lal Lal Hotel.

Registration: On arrival report to registration. Registration will be open from 10 AM. Rental SI sticks can be collected at registration. **Start times** from 11 AM till Noon. Finish closes at 2:30 PM

This is indicated by a beep / red flash from the SI box. If the SI box fails to register, use the manual punch on your map or punch card, if one is provided.

- Visit controls in number order. Check the control code is correct.
- Only ride on marked tracks or full yellow. Don't go through the bush.
- You must stay with the bike at all times
