Permitted deviations from IOF WRE rules - high quality digital printing of maps

Following consultation with the IOF Mapping Commissioner and under the direct hands-on supervision of each of the three IOF Event Advisors, all maps will be digitally printed by a commercial printer using a *Hewlett Packard Indigo* printer especially set up for orienteering maps. Maps for elite courses in the Australian Long Distance Championships will be printed on 113gsm Impress Satin paper and sealed in plastic bags. All other maps will be printed on Pretex, a waterproof and tear-resistant paper now commonly used in major events in Australia.

Technical information, start procedures, rules, and protests

Comprehensive technical information for competitors is set out in the recently published Carnival Technical Bulletin which is available on IOF Eventor and the websites below.

In accordance with IOF Rules, the jury for each event shall consist of 3 voting members, from different Federations if possible. The IOF Event Adviser for the event shall lead the jury but has no vote. Jury members will be selected from the IOF licensed Event Advisers available at the event.

Event centre - location and hours of opening

If you arrive in Ballarat on Friday 25 September, make your way to the Eastwood Leisure Complex, 20 Eastwood Street Ballarat, one block south of the main town centre, between about midday and 6 pm to obtain your registration pack including chest bib and other information. From Saturday morning onwards, registration will be available in a tent at each event for about an hour or more before first start time. You must wear your number bib to be eligible to be included in results.
