About This Event:

The Esk Valley Orienteering Club runs an annual Northern Schools Orienteering Championship which along with a state-wide Schools Championship and nominated state selection events provides a pathway for young orienteering athletes towards possible selection in the Tasmanian Schools orienteering team. All of these events are under the direction, guidelines and rules of Orienteering Tasmania Inc.

Entry is open to any student at primary or secondary school or College.

Where is the Start?

Travel along Reatta Road, Trevallyn and turn left into Duck Reach Road, just past the Ranger Station. Assembly and start area is approximately 1 kilometer along Duck Reach Road on the right (the old horse paddock). Watch for signs.

When Can I Start?

Start times are between 9.30am and 2pm. Please indicate approximate arrival time when entering. Course closure is at 3.00pm.
