

Sunday 21 March – Archie's and The Glen Mine Extended, south west of Warwick

Maps: *Archie's* 1:5,000 for the Easy and Very Easy courses; *The Glen Mine Extended* – a northern and western extension of the Archies map - scale will be at 1:10,000 for the Hard and Moderate courses

Terrain: *Archie's* - Undulating open woodland and open grazing land in spur/gully terrain with some scattered rock features and areas disturbed by road-foundation quarrying.

Glen Mine Extended – Open grazing land and forest including an extensive area of complex granite to the west with good views of Leslie Dam. The grass in the open paddocks is reasonably runnable. There is some scratchy undergrowth amongst the boulders so full body cover is recommended on the harder courses.



Courses: Hard 1 – 7.1km; Hard 2 – 6.5km; Hard 3 – 5.2km; Hard 4 – 4.5km; Hard 5 – 3.5km; Moderate 1 – 3.7km; Moderate 2 – 2.9km; Easy – 2.3km; Very Easy – 1.4km

Water on courses:

Because of Covid restrictions, we would request that everyone carry their own water supplies for this event – a camelback or water bottle. We will have emergency supplies in individual bottles at track crossings. If you need to use these, take one bottle and after a drink put it in the box supplied so that it is not used by other competitors.

Directions: From Warwick, travel towards Stanthorpe on the New England Highway and cross the railway line past the hospital . Turn right (west) onto Glen Road and at 850m, veer left to stay on Glen Road. Continue west for 6km and turn left (south) onto Ford Road. Follow Ford Road for 2.4km – take care at the dip in the road - and turn right through a gate into the archery club. Please ensure you leave this gate OPEN, then follow the track and signs 300m to the assembly area. Allow 15 mins travel time from Warwick.

From Toowoomba , travel through Warwick and turn towards Stanthorpe on the New England Highway. Cross the railway line past the hospital. Proceed as above. Allow 75 mins travel time.

From Stanthorpe, proceed north along the New England Highway for approx. 56km to the southern outskirts of Warwick. **Just before** crossing the railway, turn left (west) onto Glen Road and proceed as above. Allow 55 mins travel time.
