

# Camping at Canobolas Scout Camp for Easter and NSW Champs.

Hello Orienteers,

Thank you for your booking at Canobolas Scout Camp for Easter and the NSW Champs carnival. Please check your booking details and let me know if they are incorrect.

## **COST**

Camping: \$10/Adult and \$5/Child

Dormitory: \$16.50/Person

## **ARRIVAL**

Arrival and check-in will be from 4pm on Friday 2nd April. Please do not arrive earlier!

If you are towing, you may drop your camper/caravan/trailer at the camp earlier in the day, but you will have to reconnect and move it to your final camping location, in the afternoon. Sorry about this, but we have a lot of people over the Easter weekend and need to coordinate who camps where.

The plan is to mark campsites with small wands and to designate areas for those camping just for the Easter weekend, and those camping all week. Within these limitations, you will still be free to choose your own campsite and camping neighbours.

If you arrive earlier and set up your camp, then you will almost certainly be asked to move, and nobody wants that!

## **CHECK-IN**

Please check-in with the QR code that will be available at the gate and at the Mess Hall.

## **FAMILY TRAINING CAMP**

NSW and ACT will be holding a joint camp, open to all juniors and their families (from all states and territories), during the week from Friday 2nd to Sunday 11th April. There will be presentations at 5pm most days, so please stay away from the Mess Hall if you are not attending the presentations. You are very welcome to attend the presentations - the full program will be on Eventor this week.

## **PAYMENT**

Will be on arrival at the camp, in cash. Details in your email.

## **COVID RESTRICTIONS**

The Mess Hall has a maximum limit of **68 people** at a time. Everybody shares responsibility to make sure that we don't exceed this capacity.

Please sanitise (BYO) before using this communal area.

Given that we have around 110 people booked for the Easter weekend (and up to 60 midweek), we will need to have a roster for the Mess Hall. We strongly encourage you to use your own cooking facilities, and eat out when you can.

The roster will limit access to the kitchen and mess hall during the evening. The roster will be at the Mess Hall allowing you to book kitchen time and indoor seating for dinner. Please self-monitor numbers in the Mess Hall during the rest of the day. There is an outdoor undercover area and a fire pit as well, so if the weather is fine, it really shouldn't be a problem.

## **MESS HALL/KITCHEN**

There is no dishwashing equipment supplied, so please bring detergent, scourers, tea towels etc.

There are 2 or 3 fridges and a freezer available for us to use. There is also a Cool Room. Please allow the Freezer space to be used for campers to freeze their ice blocks and, as much as possible, keep your cool food in your own esky. If you need to use the fridge, please have your food in labelled bags, and take it all with you when you depart the camp. Thank you!

## **RESIDENCE**

There is a residence on the Scout Camp site which is currently being rented privately. Please keep away from the residence at all times. Please keep your children away too.

## **LAUNDRY**

There is no laundry or washing machines on site. The nearest (only?) laundromat is in Orange at 99 Glenroi Ave, Orange. It seems to be open till 10pm daily and hopefully this will be the case over the long weekend.

## **POWER**

Powered sites are not available.

## **NOISE**

Please keep quiet around the camp from 8pm every evening. All noise must stop completely at 10pm.

## **MOUNTAIN BIKES**

The camp is next door to a mountain bike park and over the road from Lake Canobolas. Both areas offer great bike riding options, so if you can fit in a bike or three, we recommend it!
