



## Metro League #1 – Event Information

**Date:** Sunday 18 April 2021

**Venue:** Yerambah Lagoon, Picnic Point

**Map:** Yerambah Lagoon. Scale: 1:7500 - 5m contours

**Start Window:** 9.30am – 11.30am

**Course closure:** 12.30pm

**Covid safety:** Please read the Covid participant instructions and ensure you are registered as either a competitor or a volunteer. Everyone who attends this event must be registered for contact tracing. If you have not pre-entered on Eventor, please check in on the day with your mobile phone using our QR code at the registration point.

**Parking:** Parking will be in surrounding residential streets. Please be mindful when parking outside homes keeping all residential driveways and accesses clear. Park sensibly, arrive and leave quietly to minimise noise nuisance to residents. Allow yourself extra time to walk to the start from your vehicle.

**Assembly & Start:** will be located at the eastern end of Burns Road. Starts are from 10.00am-10.30am for metro league competitors. There will be no briefing. Team captains will issue start times to their teams. Metroleague competitors should then head to the start (approx 100m from Assembly) for their allotted time. Proceed as directed. Avoid congregating in groups as per covid requirements. Clear and check stations will be located at the start.

**Finish:** location as above. Please make your way to the download station as soon as you have completed your course. All competitors must pass through the Finish and download SI sticks. There will be no results boards. Results will be available later online.

**SI Air:** All controls will be SIAC enabled. The start and finish must be punched manually.

**Control descriptions:** Control symbols will be printed on the maps. Descriptions in English and in international format will be available on Eventor for printing.

### Course Setter's Notes:

Yerambah Lagoon was remapped/updated in February 2021 by Arpad Kocsik of Garingal Orienteers. The area has an extensive track network. There are a number of indistinct tracks, some are mapped and others are not. The light green areas on the map vary in degree of vegetation thickness out in the forest but most of it has moderate runnability. Not all termite mounds in the area have been mapped.

There are 2 major roads bordering two sides of the map. River Road to the east and Henry Lawson Drive to the south both of which are OUT OF BOUNDS. Safety bearing for all courses is north.

**Facilities: THERE ARE NO TOILETS** at the event. Allow extra time to avail yourself use of toilet facilities elsewhere before you arrive. Closest toilets to event: from M5 turnoff, head south along Henry Lawson Drive to Monash Reserve (open Sun 8am-6pm) or Lambeth Reserve (open daylight hrs). Approaching from the east toilets can be found in the Georges River National Park off Henry Lawson Drive (open daylight hrs). Toilets also available at Fitzpatrick Park, Carinya Rd (off Henry Lawson Dr) follow signage to Fitzpatrick Park.

**BYO Water:** In line with covid requirements there will be **NO DRINKING WATER** supplied at the start, finish or on courses. Please bring plenty of water with you particularly if the weather forecast is for warm weather.

**Enter on the day:** Limited courses will be available. Report to the Registration desk. You will be required to check in with your mobile phone using our QR code. Payment will be accepted by card – sorry no cash. Enter on the day starts will be available between 9.30-10am and 10.30-11.30am.
