

## Monday 26 April – *Dalmoak*, Marylands, east of Stanthorpe



**Map:** *Dalmoak*, 2000 but updated numerous times. 1:10,000 scale

### **Terrain:**

Generally undulating open forest and semi-open to open grazing land with some scattered areas of granite. There are some areas of former tin mining along the major creek. Occasional patches of thicker vegetation.

**Courses:** Hard 1 – 6.9km; Hard 2 – 5.0km; Hard 3 – 3.7km;  
Moderate 1 – 4 km; Moderate 2 – 3.1km; Easy – 2.3km; Very Easy – 2.4km

**Entries:** Enter online via Eventor by midnight on Wednesday 18 April.

**Starts:** 9 - 11am      **Courses close:** 1pm

**Cost:** Members - Adults \$10; Juniors \$8; Families \$27

Beginners: \$5

**Facilities:** Bush toilet

**Water on courses:**

Because of Covid restrictions, we would request that everyone carry their own water supplies for this event – a camelback or water bottle. We will have emergency supplies in individual bottles at gates in the dog fence. If you need to use these, take one bottle and after a drink put it in the box supplied so that it is not used by other competitors.

**Directions:**

From Warwick, travel south towards Stanthorpe on the New England Highway for 47km to the turn off to Thulimbah (the Big Apple). Continue for a further 2km and take Ridge Road on the left. (if you cross the railway line at The Summit you have gone too far). Follow for 1.9km to the border crossing into New South Wales where it becomes Summit Road. A further 1.1km on, turn right into Dalmoak Road. Follow this gravel road and O signs 3km to the assembly area and park as directed. You will pass through a gate in the *Dalmoak* property along this road so please ensure it is closed. Allow 55 mins travel time from Warwick.

From Stanthorpe, take Amosfield Road off High Street and follow east for 6.5km before crossing into NSW. A further 500m further on, turn left into Dalmoak Road. Follow this gravel road for approx. 4km to the assembly area. You will pass through a gate in a high dog fence along this road so please ensure it is closed. Allow 20 mins travel time from Stanthorpe.
