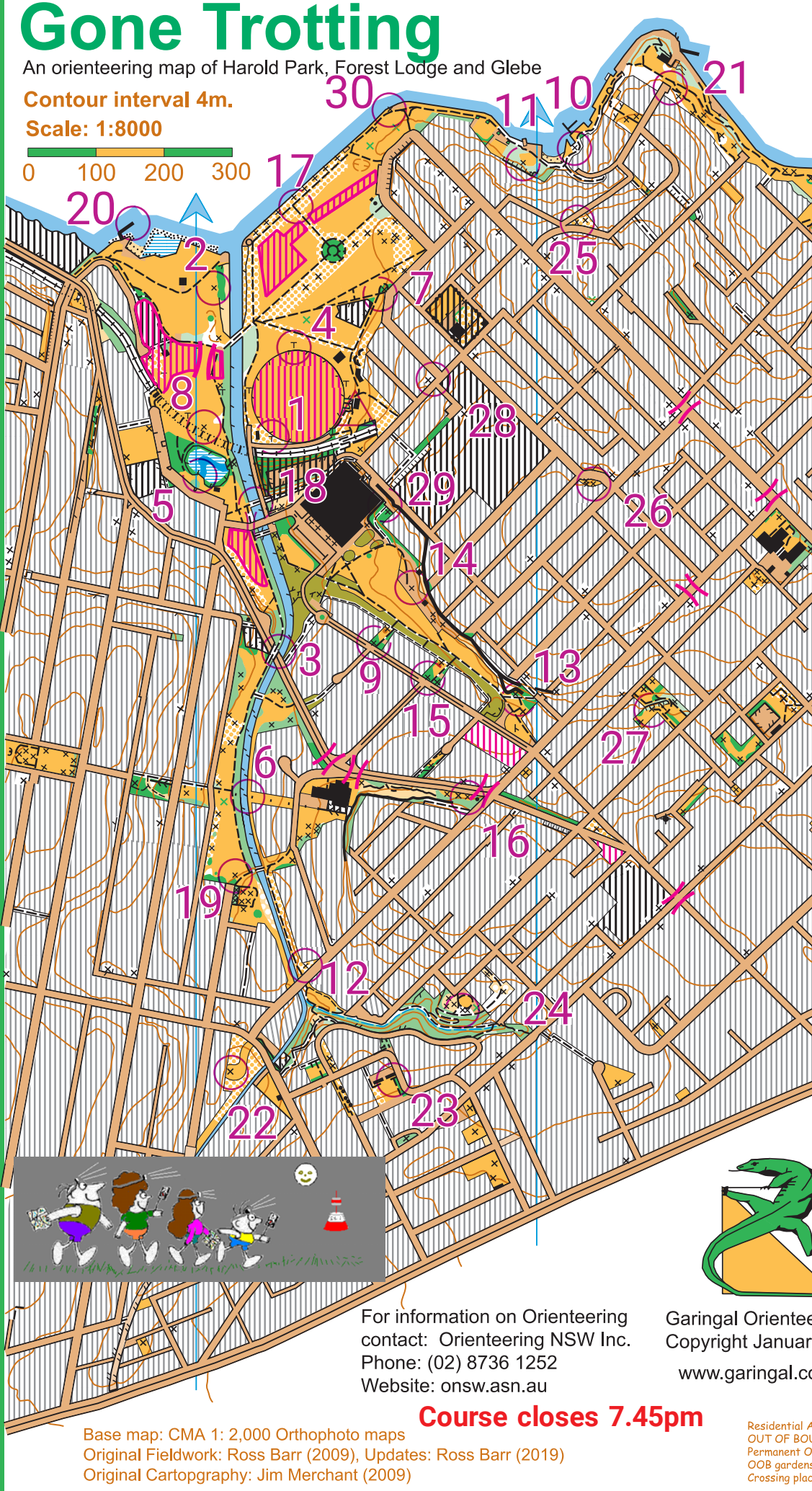


# Gone Trotting

Contour interval 4m.

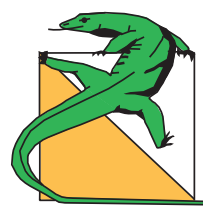
