# Victorian Club Relays – 6 June 2021

Organising Club: Bendigo Orienteers

Directions: Travel to Heathcote. Turn into Spring Flat Road and travel south for approximately 1.5kms. Parking will be available adjacent to the arena, with additional parking less than 300m walk from the arena.

Map: Argyle (Heathcote) at 1:10,000

Mapped by Neil Barr, the map is characterised by fast open forest interspersed with gold mining details. There is a dense track network across the map.



Courses: Four courses will be provided (approximate distances):

- Course 1 5.6km hard physical/navigation
- Course 2 4.2km hard physical/navigation
- Course 3 2.8km moderate physical/moderate navigation
- Course 4 2.5km easy physical/navigation
- Course 5 Mixed comprising 1x Course 4, 1x Course 2 and 1x Course 3

Entry: Entry is paid for by clubs, not individuals.

Clubs will assign a Team Manager to enter teams (see following page for further information)

On the day: Registration will open at 10am for team managers to collect team lists, bibs/safety pins, and any other information. Competitor briefing will be at 10.45am with first runners starting at 11am sharp.



## **How to Enter**

### STEP 1 - Indicate your interest in competing

Nominate your interest in running in the Relays by entering. <u>Entries close Sunday 30 May at midnight.</u>

- Log into Eventor and go to the Victorian Club Relays Individual Entries event
- Enter the event selecting the appropriate course you want to run

#### STEP 2 - Reserve Teams

Team structures are entered by a club "Entry Manager" in Eventor. The number of teams must be finalised by <u>Tuesday 2 June at midnight</u> to allow sufficient time to print the maps.

- Log into Eventor and go to the Victorian Club Relays event
- Click on "Enter teams / Submit team line-ups"
- Choose Enter Multiple New Teams
- Nominate the NUMBER of teams for your club in each class 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 (mixed).
- Nominate yourself as Team Manager and provide your contact phone number.
- You can enter names now or save the Team Structure and enter names later.

### STEP 2 - Enter Team Line-up

Team line-ups are entered by a club "Entry Manager" in Eventor. Team line-ups must be finalised by 10am on the day of the event.

- Log into Eventor and go to the Victorian Club Relays event
- Click on "Enter teams / Submit team line-ups"
- Click on the Edit button beside each team.
- Choose the name of the team member for each leg and edit as required.
  - Build your teams from the entries in the <u>Victorian Club Relays Individual</u> Entries event.
  - You can submit teams with members from different clubs however those teams will be unofficial.
- Enter MIXED teams in the following order:
  - Leg 1 = Short
  - o Leg 2 = Long
  - Leg 3 = Medium
- Ensure each team member has an SI number
  - If a team member needs to hire an SI stick, leave the number blank and we will allocate one. There will be a hire fee of \$5 per stick.

Entry Fee: \$20 per Adult and \$10 per Junior
