1	M21A M20A (M17-20A) M35A	3.0-3.4km	Moderate / Hard	15 minutes (25 – 30 min)
2	M16A M45A W21A W20A (W17-20A) W35A	2.4-2.8km	Moderate / Hard	15 minutes (25 – 30 min)
3	W16A W45A M55A	2.0-2.4km	Moderate / Hard	15 minutes (25 – 30 min)
4	W55A, M65A, W65A, M75A, W75A, M85A, W85A	1.5 – 2km	Moderate / Hard	15 minutes (25 – 30 min)
5	M12A, W12A	1.5 – 2km	Easy	12 minutes (25 – 30 min)

There are no A short or B classes because this event is short and sweet for everyone. While you may get a little geographically embarrassed within the scout camp it is not possible to become truly lost.

It is not possible to offer a separate M/W10 course because very easy navigation cannot be guaranteed.

**Start times will be pre-allocated for championship competitors from 9am onwards.** Start lists will be available on Eventor (linked through the Orienteering SA website) by Friday Feb 27<sup>th</sup> at the absolute latest.

Enter on the day will be possible - from approximately 10am - but not in championship age classes.

Newcomers and groups are welcome to enter the course of their choice without age restrictions.
