COURSE NOTES:

- The area was updated in 2022 by Jack Dowling to ISSprOM2019 standards.
- The map scale is 1:4000 with 2.5 m contours.
- The many BBQs are mapped as small areas of paving, not black crosses.
- In a late development, Whiteman Park has started upgrading the rails on the tram track through the middle of the village. It is barricaded off and will be marked on your maps. You can run down either side in parts. Course adjustments have been made.
- The Long and Short courses have a control on the only sandhill on the map.
- Whiteman Park on a Sunday is very busy – there will be a lot of vehicles in the carparks and people everywhere in the public areas – due caution and courtesy are essential.
- The event centre is Shelter C in the Village (northern) part of the Park – check the Park map included in Eventor. Toilets are nearby.
- The eastern (Drumpelliar Drive) entry to the Park is closed (Metronet construction) – access is only available from the west (Beechboro Road via Tonkin Hwy) and the south (Dulwich Street via Marshall Road) – see the Metronet map on Eventor.
- Access should be available at both entrances from 08:00.
