Your Group is required to bring the following :-

Sheets, sleeping bags or blankets, pillows, towels and personal requirements. If self catering:- tea towels, detergent, wipes. Wood for fires is not supplied. Bags of wood can be purchased at local service stations.

Catering

Catering can be arranged and is well recommended. \$40 p/person p/day will provide your group with Breakfast, M/T, Lunch, A/T, Dinner and Supper. Packed lunches and snacks can be provided. Part catering is also available. All meals include plenty of fresh fruit and vegetables. Special dietary needs can be catered for.(A surcharge applies). Please check with managers for further information. Catering to be paid in full on arrival.

Self Catering

If this option is chosen, the hirer accepts all responsibility associated with the safe storage, transport, preparation, handling, cooking and serving of food supplies and for thoroughly cleaning all kitchen equipment and facilities and other responsibilities as listed or conveyed to the hirer.

Cleaning

Users of Koolamurt Park are required to keep camp clean during their stay and clean facilities before departure. Cleaning can be arranged at an additional cost. Deep Cleaning costs still apply to each camp to ensure the health and safety of users.

Camp Attendance

A complete list of campers must be provided by the hirer on or before arrival. A copy of the proposed program is also required to assist staff in their required roles.

CAMPSITE FEES

Overnight Usage :-

\$15.00 per person per night for Accommodation Centre.

\$ 5.00 per person per night for use of the toilets and showers only if camping.

Minimum fees :-

Overnight Booking for Accommodation Centre - \$300 per night
Includes Huts, Rec. Hall, Kitchen/Dining Room & Showers/WC.

Deep clean cost- \$150.00 per camp

Additional cleaning fees may apply if managers not satisfied with users departure clean up.

Short Term Usage of Function Facilities :-

\$120.00 for day use of Dining Room, Kitchen, Hall and Toilets. (Bond \$120.00)

\$ 50.00 for day use of Hall and toilets (Bond \$50.00)

\$ 70.00 for day use of Kitchen, Dining Room and toilets (Bond \$70.00)

Training Centre- \$100 p/day for Training Centre Only.

General Conditions :-

The booking deposit reverts to a bond which will be returned after inspection of the campsite by the caretakers. Bookings will be accepted up to 12 months in advance. The deposit is required within 14 days of the initial booking. If not complied with, the booking may be cancelled. Deposits will not be refunded if booking is cancelled less than 4 weeks prior to arrival. Campsite fees are to be paid in full, to the caretakers or their representative, prior to departure from the camp.

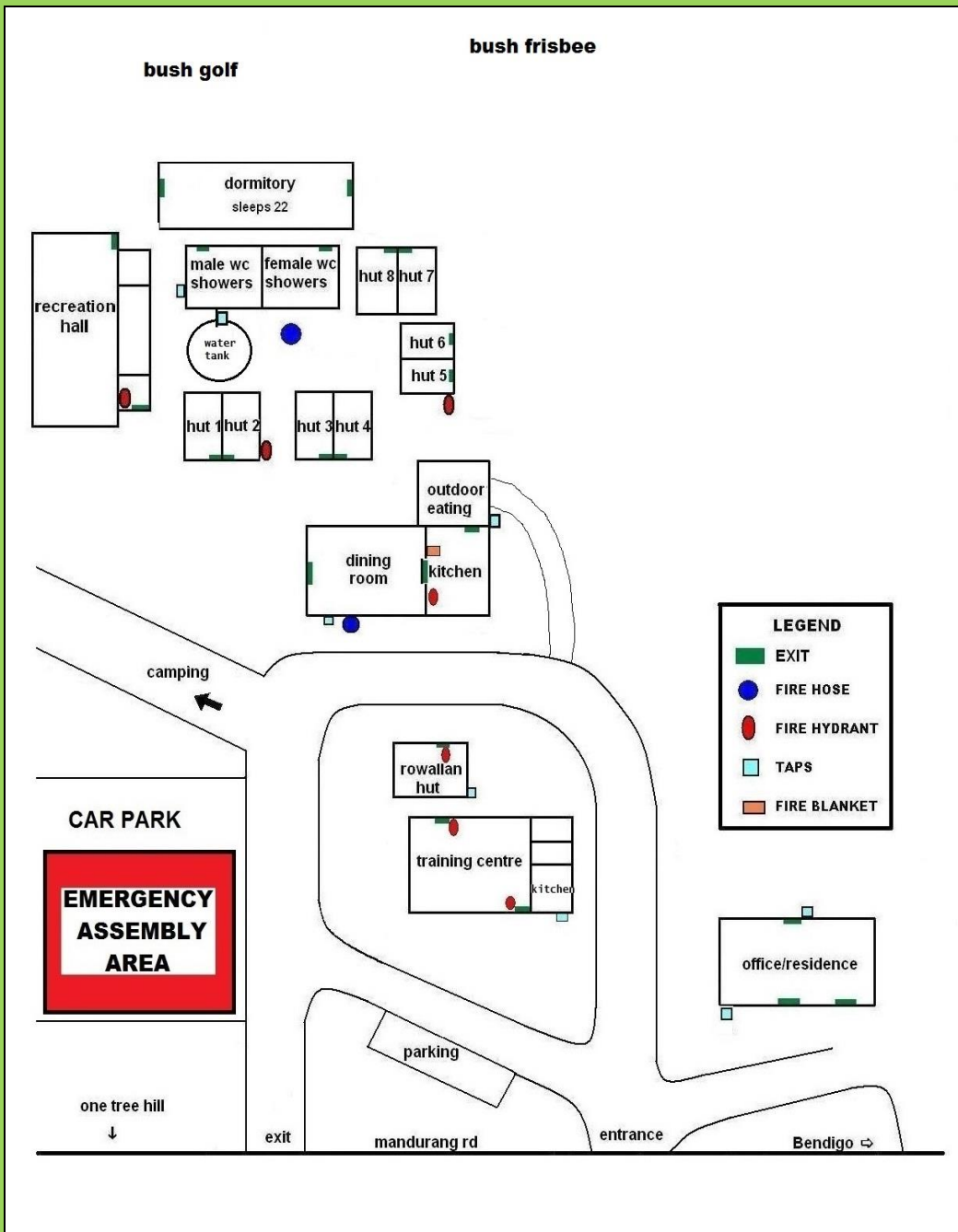

CONDITIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The member in charge of the group must ensure that camp users understand and follow camp rules.

CARE OF PROPERTY The buildings and sites, equipment etc. are owned by the Scout Association of Australia. It will be the responsibility of all campers to maintain them in good condition. It is the responsibility of the leader in charge to inspect camp daily.

GROUNDS Koolamurt Park is Land for Wildlife. Please do not damage vegetation anywhere, taking care of all trees, shrubs and flowers. Do not harm any animals or birds. Please do not leave rubbish in bush.

CLEANING Camp Users are responsible for keeping camp facilities clean during their stay. Cleaning equipment is provided. Camp **MUST** be left clean on departure or cleaning costs will be deducted from deposit bond. Cleaning can be arranged at an additional cost. A Covid deep clean will be applied after departure.

FIRE WOOD Users are required to supply own firewood. Bags of wood can be purchased at local outlets. Chain saws are not to be used on site.

EQUIPMENT Under no circumstances is any equipment or fixtures, including mattresses, to be moved or removed. An AED unit is situated near front door of dining room. Costs associated with use and misuse of AED will be charged to user.

REFUSE All rubbish to be placed in bins and securely covered.

DAMAGE & LOSS All damage & losses, including incorrect discharge of fire extinguishers, to be reported as they occur. These will be charged on final account.

ALCOHOL No alcohol is permitted on premises without written permission from Campsite Committee.

SMOKING Smoking is prohibited in ALL buildings in the camp. Please put butts in bins.

NOISE LEVEL After 10.30pm, noise level must be kept to a minimum so neighbours & other campers are not affected.

FIREARMS No Firearms or Fireworks are allowed on the property.

OPEN FIRES No open fires to be lit without prior approval from caretakers. This rule will be strictly enforced. State fire restrictions apply.

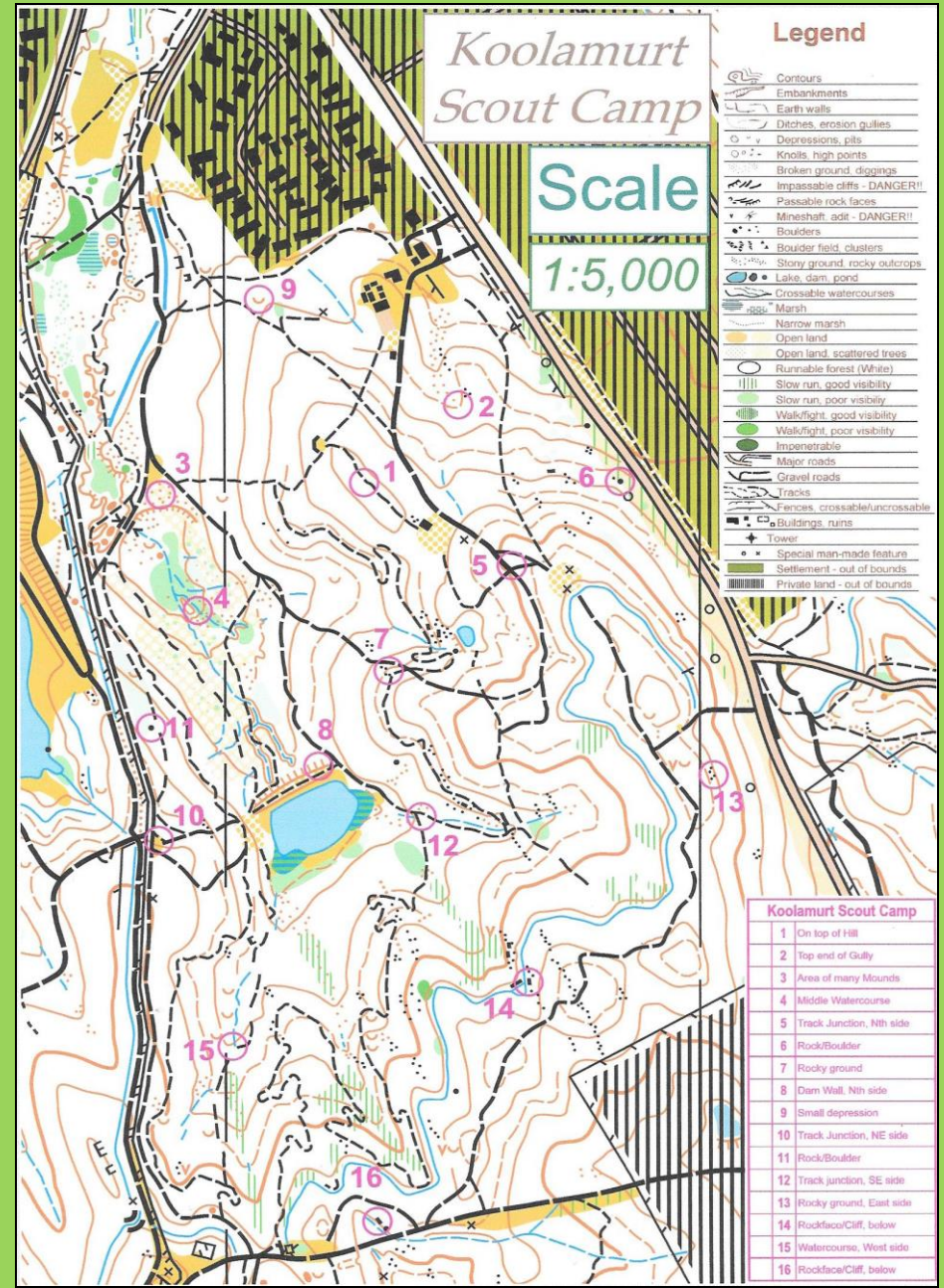
PETS No pets are allowed in the park. **Koolamurt is Land for Wildlife.**
