Terrain:

Urban area with buildings, car parks, playing fields, open spaces, relatively flat terrain.

Parking:

Parking will be signposted off Mastermann St, Bruce - East Carpark GIO Stadium.

Assembly Area:

150 m west of parking.

Start:

The Start is approximately 250m from either Parking or Assembly. **P**lease follow pink and blue tapes and take care when crossing the multi-use path.

Start Time:

Queuing start from 10am - 11am.

Remember to Clear and Check before entering the Start area.

There will be a 1 minute Start Interval on each Course. There will be a punching Start.

DO NOT look at your map until you have punched the Start Unit.

Event Timing:

All units in the field and the **Finish** units will be set for contactless punching (Beacon Mode) if you are using a SIAC chip. Please ensure that you have an audible or visual response from each SI unit. If a SIAC chip does not respond, please do a manual punch. If you do not receive a response from either the SI unit or SI chip, please punch in the Reserve boxes on the map and advise the finish officials.

Finish:

The Finish is adjacent to Assembly.

Maps will not be collected at the Finish. In the interest of fairness, please DO NOT show your map to anyone who has not started.

Please return to and record the finish even if you are abandoning your course.

DO NOT forget to download after finishing.

Course Closure:

Courses close at 12.30.

You must return to the finish by this time whether you have completed your course on not.

Controls will be collected from 1230.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THIS EVENT

Courses 1 – 3 have a double-sided map.

Part 1 of the course will be on one side of the map and Part 2 will be on the other side.

When you pick up your map, Part 1 will be facing down in the start box.

At the last control on Part 1, flip your map over to Part 2 and continue the course.

Part 2 does not have a start triangle. The last control on Part 1 is the first control on Part 2.

Out of Bounds Areas:

Some areas of Out of Bounds (Olive or Dark Green on the map) are taped with OACT White bunting where they appear less obvious on the ground. Please do not cross these tapes. Please refer to the Out-of-Bounds document on Eventor for more information.

Traffic:

The event is being held in a public place. Although unlikely, there may be traffic around some areas of the course. Please take care when crossing parking areas.

There will also be pedestrian traffic in some areas. Please be courteous to everyone and take care when racing around blind corners.

Presentations:

A presentation for place getters in Championship classes will be made as soon as results are finalised. Competitors in M/W10N will also receive a memento of the event.
