

Event Information

Sun 10 July – Lode Creek, east of Stanthorpe



Terrain: Undulating, semi-open and forested grazing land with areas of scattered granite. Generally good running as most of the paddocks have been grazed but ground is still very wet in parts so you will get your feet wet.

Map: *Border Hills, 2021; 1:10,000; 5m contour interval*

Courses: Hard 1 – 7.7km; Hard 2 – 5.9km; Hard 3 – 4.7km; Hard 4 – 3.1km; Moderate 1 – 3.5km; Moderate 2 – 2.6km; Easy – 2.4km; Very Easy – 2.3km

Entries: Enter online via Eventor by **Wednesday 6 July** to ensure enough maps are available. Only a limited number of spare maps will be available on the day.

Directions:

From the main road through Stanthorpe, head south through town and after crossing over Quart Pot Creek, take the Sugarloaf Road (second on the left). Follow for 4km until it veers left off what now becomes Eukey Road. Continue following the Sugarloaf Road for a further 6.7km before turning left into Lode Creek Road. This is a good gravel road, suitable for all cars. Follow for 2km and park as directed. This road is the access for our landowners, so be aware of other traffic and do not block it.

There will be a 700m track walk towards the start, followed by a short uphill climb. There will be a remote finish about 100m from the assembly area.
