Course Setters Notes - Wed Nov 2nd.

Gully Gully Gosh

Allow ten minutes walk to the start. Safety bearing east to a fence then south to car park

Moderate courses - maps available at start

For moderate enthusiasts you will find that <u>every</u> control is placed in a vague gully – a great way to improve your contour reading and to read the subtle spurs and gullies without the risk of getting truly lost – (there are plenty of safety catching features such as tracks or fences). There will be three moderate courses. Moderate 3 is shorter than usual and designed to avoid all fences and hills. Moderate 1 is a bit longer and harder than usual so start by 6.10 pm for this one. Watch out for the Halloween control – a fake one to lead you astray!

Easy and Very Easy courses – maps available at registration

These are a bit harder than usual as for a change they use a different area to the usual. So don't try a level above your usual today. If following a creek make sure you follow the creek.

Wildlife
