ABOUT THE AREA: The map includes part of the highly developed residential area of East Perth, a narrow strip of riverside parkland, some commercial streets, older suburbia and the East Perth power station (which is under redevelopment and out of bounds).

ASSEMBLY AREA: Mardalup Park is at the east end of Brown St. There are trees for shade but no built facilities other than a childrens' playground.

PARKING: **Parking options are likely to be limited** because there is a concurrent BBL game at Optus Stadium. There is a small carpark adjacent to the assembly area and there might be some parking on nearby streets. The CPP Royal Street carpark (ticketed) is at the western edge of the map and you might be able to use the TAFE carpark at the northern end of Fielder Street, adjacent to Claisebrook station.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Claisebrook station is on the western edge of the map, just under a km walk or cycle from Mardalup Park. The Yellow CAT terminus is adjacent to Claisebrook station and it has a stop at Victoria Gardens.

TOILETS: There are public toilets in Victoria Gardens, 300m south across the footbridge.

HOT WEATHER: Bring plenty of water.
OWA has health and safety protocols that require cancellation of events in some extreme weather conditions. If the day is hot, monitor email and Eventor for updates. If the event is cancelled entry fees will be refunded.

MAP NOTES: Scale 1:8000 (not the usual 1:10,000). There will be copies on display.
There are four underpasses under major roads. These are shown using the purple "crossing point" symbol.

Different symbols are used for high and low bridges.

The symbol for stairs on pedestrian paths is generally exaggerated.

A legend is included on the map and a copy of the basic legend is available under Documents and Links in Eventor.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Gardens are shown with a very Dark Green.

Private land, including residential and shop/business premises is shown with Green hatching (or solid colour for very small areas).

Other out of bounds areas are shown with Purple hatching.

ENTRIES: Please enter online via Eventor before you arrive at the event, if you can.

If you are not a member of OWA you will need to register an account on Eventor in order to pre-enter. Once you have an Eventor account select the event and enter and pay online with Paypal.

WHAT TO BRING: Dress comfortably in walking or running gear appropriate to the weather forecast and be sure to bring a water bottle.

If you have one, bring your Sportident card. Those without will be allocated one at registration.

ENTRY FEES:

Casual Members: Adult \$20, Junior/Concession \$10, Group/Family Max \$30
(Group with all Juniors and/or Concession \$20)

Full Members: Adult \$10, Junior/concession \$5, Group/Family max \$20
(Group with all Juniors and/or Concession \$10)

Under 7s free with a paying adult.

Up to 5 people allowed in a group.

COURSES AVAILABLE: There are courses – Short (3 km), Medium (5 km) and Long (8 km), determined by the number of controls to be visited.
All distances are approximate and dependant on route choice!

COURSE CLOSES: 6.15pm

You **MUST** return to the start and download your Sportident card by this time. Otherwise, we will assume you are still out and start a search. Please act responsibly and help the event run smoothly.
