

Environmental Conditions for Orienteering at Simmos Beach Reserve – Metro 1 on the Sunday 10 May 2015

1. As per the maps on display and map section below, no entry is permitted into the identified area, which is recovering from a small bush fire late in 2014. The eastern boundary of this area will be identified with a band of red/white tape.
2. Shoes need to be treated with 70% w/v methylated spirits and water solution prior at the start, assembly area and at select entry points to the reserve. Visible red plastic trays will be available as noted on the maps on display. See locations marked with the)(symbols in map section below.
3. No shoes with spikes or studs are to be worn by any participants.
4. Shoes, hats and clothes must be cleaned prior to reserve entry.
5. The event and start briefing will also re-state the environmental values of the reserve and the key conditions above.
6. Please park in designated parking areas or outside of the Simmos Beach reserve. Reserve roads are narrow – see reserve entrance below.
7. Please use litter bins provided.
8. **Council rangers and environmental officers will be present** at the event. They will be monitoring certain sites and our conduct.
