ABOUT THE AREA: The map covers parts of the suburbs of Mt Pleasant, Brentwood and Booragoon. It includes mostly residential areas with some small parks and bushland around Booragoon Lake and Blue Gum Lake and along the Canning River. The map is bounded by Riseley Street in the west, Leach Highway in the south, the Canning River in the east and Queens Road and Glencoe Road in the north.

ASSEMBLY AREA: The assembly area is in Mount Henry Bridge Reserve overlooking the Canning River. There is a small parking area in the reserve and there is further parking along the Esplanade under or near Mt Henry bridge as well as in other nearby streets (Curruthers Rd and Shirley Ave). There are trees for shade and a children's playground in the reserve.

TOILETS: There are public toilets at the assembly area in Mount Henry Bridge Reserve.

HOT WEATHER: Bring plenty of water.
OWA has health and safety protocols that require cancellation of events in some extreme weather conditions. If the day is hot, monitor email and Eventor for updates. If the event is cancelled entry fees will be refunded.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT: The assembly area is 1.2 km from Bull Creek train station.

MAP NOTES: Scale 1:10,000.

The Kwinana Freeway runs through the map. There are three places where the freeway can be crossed. Two are very close to the assembly area (one along the Esplanade and the second through an underpass for cyclists and pedestrians) and the third is over the Cranford Avenue bridge.

Access to some areas is through a gate; these may be closed, but not locked. They are shown on the map with a gap in the fence.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Gardens and out-of-bounds bushland are shown with a very Dark Green.

Private land is shown with Green hatching (or solid colour for very small areas).

Other out-of-bounds areas are shown with Purple hatching.

ENTRIES: Please enter online via Eventor before you arrive at the event, if you can.

If you are not a member of OWA you will need to register an account on Eventor in order to pre-enter. Once you have an Eventor account select the event and enter and pay online with Paypal.

WHAT TO BRING: Dress comfortably in walking or running gear appropriate to the weather forecast and be sure to bring a water bottle.

If you have one, bring your Sportident card. Those without will be allocated one at registration.

ENTRY FEES:

Casual Members: Adult \$20, Junior/Concession \$10, Group/Family Max \$30

(Group with all Juniors and/or Concession \$20)

Full Members: Adult \$10, Junior/concession \$5, Group/Family max \$20

(Group with all Juniors and/or Concession \$10)

Under 7s free with a paying adult.

Up to 5 people allowed in a group.

COURSES AVAILABLE: There are courses – Short (3 km), Medium (5 km) and Long (8 km), determined by the number of controls to be visited.
All distances are approximate and dependent on route choice!

COURSE CLOSES: 6.15pm

You **MUST** return to the start and download your Sportident card by this time. Otherwise, we will assume you are still out and start a search. Please act responsibly and help the event run smoothly.
