

## Orienteering Instructor Coaching Course, Killarney

<b>When</b>	Saturday 18 March 2023, 9am – 1pm
<b>Where</b>	Killarney State School, Acacia St, Killarney
<b>Cost</b>	<b>FREE for club members – \$40 membership</b> <a href="https://membership.orienteering.asn.au">Membership (orienteering.asn.au)</a> . <b>Non-members:</b> \$66. Cost includes a hardcopy of “Elementary Orienteering Instructor’s Handbook” and a pdf copy of “Orienteering Games” (see <a href="https://oq.asn.au/o-games-book">https://oq.asn.au/o-games-book</a> for more details), OR \$88 (\$22 for members) includes hard copies of both books. Student rate: \$44 (under 25)
<b>Pre-requisites</b>	Registered teacher OR Blue Card and membership of Orienteering Aus (non-teachers)
<b>Recommended</b> (not compulsory)	Current CPR and First Aid Minimum age 16 years
<b>Why</b>	Orienteering fits into HPE, Maths and Geography, as well as teaching problem solving, perseverance, self reliance and self confidence. <b>This course will qualify you to teach orienteering in your school or nearby parkland.</b> (‘Learn and Play’ is required to take students into the bush – see below).
<b>Map Rebate</b>	Orienteering requires a specially made map. School maps cost between \$300 and \$1000, depending on their complexity. For the current financial year (ending 30 June 2023), Orienteering Qld is offering a \$300 rebate to all schools to help with the cost of this map. Schools may be asked to sign an MOU to agree to allow OQ clubs to use their school map for a club event no more than once per year.
<b>Sporting Schools</b>	Orienteering is one of the sports available through Sporting Schools <a href="https://oq.asn.au/sporting-schools">https://oq.asn.au/sporting-schools</a> . If your school has an Orienteering Instructor qualified teacher you do not need to pay for a coach to run the program and the Sporting Schools grant money can be used to purchase the map and buy equipment (flags, punches, lesson plans and other resources – see <a href="https://lessonplans.orienteering.asn.au">Lesson Plans and Resources (orienteering.asn.au)</a> ).

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### Further Qualifications

The Orienteering Instructor qualification is a prerequisite for ‘**Learn and Play**’ (taking beginners into a bush setting), **Competition Coach** (coaching juniors to a state/national level) and **Performance Coach** (coaching elites).
