**Terrain:** Complex tin mining terrain and undulating, semi-open and forested grazing land with areas of scattered granite. Generally good running as most of the paddocks have been grazed. Some swampy areas in the tin mining so people on the hard courses may get their feet wet.

From the main road through Stanthorpe, head south through town and after crossing over Quart Pot Creek, take the Sugarloaf Road (second on the left). Follow for 4km until it veers left off what now becomes Eukey Road. Continue following the Sugarloaf Road for a further 6.7km before turning left into Lode Creek Road. This is a good gravel road, suitable for all cars. Follow for 4km and park as directed. This road is the access for our landowners, so be aware of other traffic and do not block it.

There will be a 500m flat track walk to the start. There will be a remote finish about 100m from the assembly area.
