# Sunday 2 July – Dalmoak, Marylands, east of Stanthorpe

# Terrain:

Generally undulating open forest and semi-open to open grazing land with some scattered areas of granite. There are some areas of former tin mining along the major creek.

#### Notes on the map:

There is a high, electrified wild dog exclusion fence running east – west through "Dalmoak", marked as uncrossable on the map. All Hard and Moderate courses will cross it twice at gates. Please do NOT attempt to cross this fence at any other point as you may damage it. If you are seen/reported doing this, you will be disqualified.

The map was originally made in 1999. Since then, a number of changes have occurred,

particularly to the vegetation. Many of the minor tracks have now become indistinct. Some of the clearings are also less distinct and areas of "green" may now be denser vegetation. Extensive wattle regrowth has occurred in sections of the open paddocks. Only some of this has been updated on the map.

**Courses:** Hard 1 – 7km; Hard 2 – 4.7km; Hard 3 – 3.5km; Moderate 1 – .4km; Moderate 2 – 2.5km; Easy – 2.5km; Very Easy – .2km

# Directions:

From <u>Warwick</u>, travel south towards Stanthorpe on the New England Highway.for 47km to the turn off to Thulimbah (the Big Apple). Continue for a further 2km and take Ridge Road on the left. (if you cross the railway line at The Summit you have gone too far). Follow for 1.9km to the border crossing into New South Wales where it becomes Summit Road. A further 1.1km on, turn right into Dalmoak Road. Follow this gravel road and O signs 2.3km before turning right into a paddock after crossing a grid. Please shut this gate after passing through. Follow the track 1km through the paddock taking care on some rough patches up a hill. Allow 55 mins travel time from Warwick.

From <u>Stanthorpe</u>, travel north on the New England Highway to The Summit. 900M after crossing the railway line, turn right into Ridge Road and follow the directions as above. Allow 20 mins travel time from Stanthorpe.
