## Map notes:

Please note the map is six years old, in places water courses are more defined than mapped.

Additionally, the termites have been very busy on this map, there are many new termite mounds and some are missing. Please do not use termite mounds for navigating use the shape of the land.

## **Course notes:**

Get excited, although this map is steep in places, it is **FAST**. There is very limited undergrowth or lantana, there has been back burning in some areas and other areas are just plain nice and open. Courses have been set to use the best parts of the map (hence the annoying *walk* to the start....). Get your route choice hats on, the legs are **long with lots choices**, do you contour or do you climb up and over, we'll let you decide.

Get keen and good luck.



There are **two** different starts: H1, H2, Easy and Very Easy will start 30m SW of the assembly area at S1.

All other courses have a 800m (40m climb) walk on the track that heads east of the assembly area at S2.
