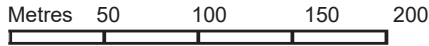


Gardens Point

- Contour (5m); Index contour (25m)
- Formline; Slope line; Earth wall
- Earth bank: Low, High
- Knoll, Elongated knoll
- Depression; Pit; Termite mound
- Rock face: Passable, Impassable
- Cave; Rocky pit; Bare Rock
- Rocks; Group of rocks; Rocky area
- Stony ground; Sandy ground
- River, Lake: Passable, Impassable
- Waterhole; Bubbler/Tap
- Stream; Ditch; Narrow marsh
- Marsh: Indistinct, Passable, Impassable
- Open land; Rough open land
- Open, Rough open with scattered trees
- Bush: Run, Jog, Walk, Fight
- Undergrowth: Jog, Walk
- Notable tree; Stump or dead tree
- Area that may not be entered (Mostly garden)
- Dirt path: Indistinct, Narrow, Wide
- (Retaining) walls: Passable, Impassable
- Power line, minor
- Fences: Passable, Impassable
- Building (Do not enter); Canopy; Pillars
- High pole, Power pylon, Other object
- Road, car park, area with traffic
- Paved area without traffic; Step or edge; Stairs
- Construction zone, Residential area

All garden beds either marked on the map or evident on the ground are strictly out of bounds. Please respect other visitors to the Gardens and give way where necessary.
