Event 1. **Qualifying Race** with 5 courses offered with an approximate winning time of 12 minutes. All competitors can choose any of the courses below.

Course 1. Open Men 3km.

- 2. Open Women 2.5km
- 3. 2.0km
- 4. 1.5km
- 5. 1km

Event 2. **Quarter Final Race**: Other than competitors in Courses 1 and 2, all other competitors will be divided into classes based on their **km rate** from the **Qualifying Race**.

The **Mass Start** races of groups of 6 will then be held from 11:00 am, the results of which will decide the top 12 competitors to go into the afternoons A Semi Final. The second 12 will be allocated to the B Semi Final, the third 12 into the C Semi Final, etc.

Quarter Final course distances will be set for an estimated winning time in each class of approximately 9 min.

PM. University of Ballarat, SMB Campus, Central Ballarat, 2:00 pm Start time.

Event 3. **Semi Final Race:** 12 from each class will compete in groups of 6. The first 3 placegetters in each heat will then qualify for the A Final. The last 3 placegetters will go into a B Final.

All competitors will follow a similar format in order to qualify for A, B, C and D finals in their groups.

Event 4. Eureka Challenge Sprint Final Race: 3:00 pm Start Time for A, B, C and D Finals in groups of 6 for all competitors. First place finishers in all finals – both men and women – will receive Eureka Challenge awards.
