## **COURSE NOTES:**

- The map scale is 1:4000 with 2.5m contours. The 2022 version will be displayed at Registration.
- 'Hard navigation' means that it may be difficult to choose and execute the best route while running at speed. Control sites are easy to find at slower speeds. The Long course will have a map flip.
- The Easy course is suitable for children and is wheelchair-accessible (paths and a few short sections of lawn). Easy course control descriptions will be in English on the map; both English and symbols will be available at the Start.
- The Start and Finish are both adjacent to the arena. It is 50 m from the pre-start to the start triangle.
- All courses include some streets that are normally quiet but will potentially have traffic; take care when crossing or running along roads. Some footpaths might be busy with walkers, runners, bikes, dogs and prams. You must give way to them all.
- Make sure you are familiar with the Out-of-Bounds symbols, especially the pale purple (mostly cafes), murky green (park gardens or private land) and purple cross-hatch areas.
  Garden/cultivated areas must not be entered or crossed even if they look totally unloved or are narrow enough to step across. Also avoid small private plantings that are too small to







map. There are some significant Noongar cultural sites and artefacts on the map; please respect them.

## **OTHER THINGS:**

- Toilets are about 400m from the arena. Head up Brown St. (west), take the first left turn (south), cross Claisebrook Cove on the Trafalgar Bridge and continue across Victoria Park. The toilets will be obvious on your right.
- The nearest drinking water is 60 m east, at the shaded playground.
- Parking at Mardalup Park is limited. If you need to park in nearby streets please approach the arena via Brown St.
- The arena is about 1km by foot or bike from Claisebrook Station. The Yellow CAT bus goes from City Farm (S of the station) to Victoria Park (adjacent to the toilets).
