Sun 10 March - Rosenthal Creek, between Warwick and Stanthorpe



Terrain: Undulating semi-open to open grazing land with some areas of thicker vegetation, particularly along Rosenthal Creek; areas of scattered granite.

Map notes: Since the map was originally made, the vegetation has thickened up in many areas, since cattle are no longer grazed here. Consequently, the grass is longer and the weeds are higher, particularly after recent rain over summer. Gaiters and old socks are recommended as there are plenty of grass and weed seeds. Some of the minor tracks are not as obvious due to this extra growth.

Directions: From <u>Warwick</u>, travel approx. 37km south on the New England Highway and turn off at Dalveen. Go past the shop and take the first turn on the left and then left into the Old Stanthorpe Road. Follow for 7.5km and turn right into Kerrick Road and follow to the assembly area. Alternatively, from Warwick take the old Stanthorpe/Warwick Road from the roundabout near the saleyards and travel for approx. 28km before turning left into Kerrick Road.

From <u>Stanthorpe</u>, take the New England Highway 20km north and turn left towards Dalveen village under the Highway. Turn right at Jim Mitchell Park and left into the Old Stanthorpe Road and travel for 7.5km before turning right into Kerrick Road.
