Want to Learn to Orienteer?

Join our “Learn to Orienteer” program in term 2.

It’s for anyone who wants to learn to orienteer – all ages are welcome.

There will be seven one-hour sessions, once a week. Lessons are conducted in small groups. We will focus on different skills and give participants plenty of opportunities to have fun exploring techniques to build confidence in using a map to navigate.
