Map: Cooradigbee 2024 (Carey's Cave 2018) This is a full revision, by Alex Davey.

Scale: 1:10000, 5m contours – NOL Classes. Scale: 1:7500, 5m contours – Public Classes.

This is limestone karst terrain, unique in Australia. Although mostly open, the map is covered with

intricate rock detail, which will make for a fast yet highly technical middle-distance race.

The area was last used in August 2019.
