

Sunday 16 June

The Glen Mine Extended, south west of Warwick

Terrain: Open grazing land and forest including an extensive area of complex granite to the west with good views of Leslie Dam. The grass in the open paddocks is reasonably runnable. There is some scratchy undergrowth amongst the boulders so full body cover is recommended on the harder courses.



Maps: 1:10,000 for all courses except for the Very Easy course where it will be 1:5,000

Courses: Hard 1 – 4.3km; Hard 2 – 3.9km; Hard 3 – 3.6km;
Moderate 1 – 3.2km; Moderate 2 – 2.7km; Easy – 1.8km; Very Easy – 1.5km

Facilities: Bush toilet

Directions: From **Toowoomba and Warwick**, head south on the New England Highway and just after passing the hospital and crossing the railway line, turn right into Glen Road. Follow for 6.1km where the name changes to Washpool Rd. Continue straight ahead and 800m past the junction with Ford Road turn left into a property gate flanked by timber rails at 463 Washpool Road. Park just inside the gate on either side of the property track. Allow 15 mins travel time from Warwick.

From **Stanthorpe**, head north on the New England Highway and just before crossing the railway line near the hospital, turn left into Glen Road and follow the directions as above. travel towards Stanthorpe on the New England Highway and cross the railway line past the hospital . Turn right (west) onto Glen Road and at 850m, veer left to stay on Glen Road. Continue west for 6km . Allow 55 mins travel time.
