



Two-level mapping in sprint maps

Current sprint mapping specifications allow for mapping of two levels with special mapping symbols. Many in WA may be unfamiliar with these symbols, so here's an explanation of the mapping of one area at Carine SHS which caused a little bit of confusion. I hope this helps.
