

Border Hills, east of Stanthorpe -Sun 18 Aug



This map was originally used for used for Day 2 of the 2021 Qld Orienteering Championships but we will be starting in the north west corner of the map which many people may not have visited. It consists of undulating semi-open and forested grazing land with areas of scattered granite - a great practice run for this year's Qld Championships on 21/22 September.

Map: *Border Hills, 2021*; 1:10,000; 5m contour interval

Map notes: Some of the vehicle tracks are less obvious than they were when the map was made in 2020 while other farm tracks may have appeared (particularly beside fences) but have not been mapped. None of the fences are electrified. A north/south fence in the middle of the map is being upgraded to ringlock, topped with a strand of barb wire and should be considered uncrossable. Those on the Hard 1 and 2 courses should be able to avoid it by heading further north.

Courses: Hard 1 – 5.3km; Hard 2 – 4.5km; Hard 3 – 3km; ; Moderate 1 – 3.4km; Moderate 2 –2.3km; Easy –1.9 km; Very Easy – 2km

Entries: Enter online via Eventor by **Wednesday 14 Aug** to ensure enough maps are available. Only a limited number of spare maps will be available on the day.

Directions: From Warwick, travel into Stanthorpe and turn left into Amosfield Road about 400m past the showgrounds. Follow for 2.4km before turning right into Gentle Road, signposted to Dalcouth. Follow Gentle Rd for about 2.4km (don't turn right into Dalcouth Road) and then go straight ahead (don't follow Gentle Rd when it turns to the left) before turning right into Mills Road. Follow for 300m before turning left into Unold Lane. This gravel road is a bit narrow so watch out for any oncoming traffic on the bends and hills. Follow for approx. 2km before turning right into a paddock as signed. The grassy track into the assembly area is a bit rough and bumpy but should be OK for conventional vehicles. Allow 60 mins from Warwick.

From Stanthorpe, head north out of town, turn right into Amosfield Road and follow the directions as above. Allow 15 mins from Stanthorpe.
