HOW TO REGISTER AT EVENTOR

Dear Participant!

A warm welcome to a vibrant celebration of Australian Mountain Bike Orienteering - **The Australian MTBO Carnival and Championships 2024, 17-20 October in Canberra!**Please read carefully all instructions on how to register for MTBO Carnival.

We are running the **MTBO Carnival** and **MTBO Championships together** to make an exciting event that is inclusive for all!

- MTBO Carnival warmly welcomes all Beginners, all Families and less competitive, more adventurous riders and social riders. If you have never tried MTBO then now is your chance! Read here for a quick overview of MTBO: https://orienteering.asn.au/what-is-mountain-bike-orienteering
- MTBO Championships warmly welcomes competitive and experienced participants, but also those who are less experienced in MTBO who want to take on a challenge and compete with more experienced MTBOers on more navigationally technical courses.

MTBO CARNIVAL & CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS:

We have 5 events over 4 days (17th; 18th; 19th; 20Th OCTOBER):

- One Warm-Up event and four Championship/Carnival events.
- You can register for all 5 events or for any one or several events.
- You can enter the same Class for all 5 events.
- Or you can enter different Classes for each Day.
- Results don't sum up.
- Each day we will have a separate Prize Giving Ceremony for each of the Championship and Carnival classes.

MTBO CARNIVAL CLASSES:

Our MTBO Carnival is very Beginner and Family friendly. We have 8 MTBO Carnival Classes – they are designed for all Beginners. If you are doing Foot Orienteering, Rogaining, Adventure Racing, Bushwalking, MTB, Cycling, Kayaking, Skiing etc., but have never tried MTBO or only a couple of times, these Carnival Classes are designed for you. They are also adventurous, but with easier navigation and easier trails that you will enjoy more.

We have 4 CARNIVAL COURSES and 8 CARNIVAL CLASSES:

Australian MTBO Carnival Classes (8 Classes)

CARNIVAL CLASSES are easier and open for all Beginners and Newcomers!

You can participate as an individual or as a team! In the latter case, each team member has to be registered through Eventor (see below). Bring your Family and Friends along and encourage them to give MTBO a try!

Beginner W (short)
Explorer W (middle)
Adventurer W (long)
Score W (solo, pairs)

Beginner M (short)
Explorer M (middle)
Adventurer M (long)
Score M (solo, pairs)

BEGINNER, **EXPLORER**, **ADVENTURER** classes have a **LINE COURSE** format, which means you have to collect each of the controls in a given order.

SCORE Class has a SCORE / ROGAINE format, which means you can collect controls in any order as long as you get to the finish under the given time limit.

Different people enjoy different formats more, so choose the most enjoyable class and format for you.

MTBO CHAMPIONSHIPS CLASSES:

We will have 22 CHAMPIONSHIPS AGE CLASSES.

M12/W12 - for kids under 12

M14/W14 - for teenagers 13-14

M16/W16 - for teenagers 15-16

M20/W20 - for teenagers 17-20

M21/W21 Elite – for Elite athletes (from about 16 until 40+, who aim to compete in the strongest male/female category

M40/W40 – for adults 40-49

M50/W50 - for adults 50-59

M60/W60 - for adults 60-69

M70/W70 - for adults 70-79

M80/W80 - for adults 80-89

M e-Bike/W e-Bike – for teenagers and adults of any age with e-Bike

To enter on the day, go to the Registration Tent at each day's arena. But we highly encourage pre-entry in every case where possible.

A maximum of 250 entries are allowed each day!

Detailed Guide: HOW TO REGISTER AT EVENTOR

If you are already a member of Orienteering ACT or other club and have an account at Eventor, please proceed to step 1 below

If you don't yet have an account at Eventor, before entering, please create your Eventor account – it defines your Name, Surname, Age, Gender, and orienteering club membership status. When you reach the page titled 'Join an orienteering club or casuals group' you may proceed to join an orienteering club (costs apply), or you may now return to the event registration page to proceed with


your event entry as a non-member. Create additional Eventor accounts to register each of your family members, the same email address may be used.

1. Choose the Event you would like to Enter, press the button (Click)

2. You see this page:



3. Press the green words Enter and/or order services in the block Entry




4. It will bring you to this page: CLUB, HIRE SERVICES, SportIdent

Please check your club (or casual), check your class (you can adjust class) and enter your **SportIdent** number if you have it, or leave blank if you don't have SportIdent stick.

See the button – available services – you can opt to hire a Map Board (for your map) and/or SI-AIR (SportIdent stick – a chip to register your attendance at all controls and to record your time). One Map Board and one SI-AIR stick cost \$5 each per day and can be collected at the REGO tent before the start. This event is operated with SI-AIR sticks only, previous older versions of SI-sticks (with no Air option) will not be accepted at the event. Please pre-purchase or hire at the event.

SI-AIR (SIAC) SportIdent stick looks like below, and should have an ID number starting with 8... (7 digits).





A Map Board is highly recommended for MTBO events. You can pre-purchase it – see Bulletin 2 & 3 for the Companies that sell them in NSW/VIC/QLD or you can Hire them at the event (please choose SERVICE HIRE during registration).


Map Board looks like below (on the left). Some people have successfully produced hand-made Map Boards, see below (on the right).

5. Then you have to choose a Class under a drop-down menu:



Based on your age and gender, all CLASSES that are suitable for you will be suggested. Please choose the most suitable class for you:

HOW CHOOSE A CLASS?

Example 1: You are a 46 year old female who has some biking, rogaining or adventure racing experience but have never tried MTBO

Then you can register in one of:

- 1) the W21 Elite Class
- 2) the **W40** for women 40-49 years old, but also welcomes older women 50-90, who are fit and keen for a tougher course
- 3) the **W e-bike class** no age limits and compete with other women on e-Bikes
- 4) the **Beginner W** class for all newcomers, no age limit, no experience required, it can be your first attempt
- 5) the **Explorer W** class for more experienced newcomers and people with some biking/navigation experience
- 6) the Adventurer W class for adventurous people with more endurance who want a bigger challenge and have some prior experience of biking, orienteering, adventure racing or rogaining
- 7) Or the **SCORE W** class (to do the course individually) or enter **SCORE PAIRS** class (to do the course as a pair, each person enters individually, but rides as a Pair). SCORE class means you collect as many controls in a specified limited time (full details and time limits in the Bulletin 2 and 3).

We would recommend to this 46 year old female to register in either W e-Bike, Explorer W, Adventurer W, or SCORE W classes. You can enter a different class for each event.

6. Then you have to tick acceptance of all Entry terms and conditions:
