A few of the scariest things for many orienteers are Grass seeds, Hills and Lantana. This map will have none of those! The terrain is mostly fast with lots of detail in the creeks which proves to be a perfect environment for a cheeky course setter such as myself. The recent

rain has certainly complicated creek crossings, however, courses have been set so that the best crossings fall upon the optimal routes so staying dry will be easy.

I was keen to put some controls on boulders, but the biggest piece of stone in the area was a pebble in one of the creeks which I couldn't find on my second time around so if you see the pebble out there, please let me know! There is exciting wildlife out there as well! Even a few friendly camels which hopefully a few lucky runners will come across.
