

EVENT INFORMATION

EVENT: **WA Long Distance Championships, Peterdine East**

DATE: **September 22, 2024**

ENTRY DETAILS: **PRE-ENTRY is REQUIRED for CHAMPIONSHIP COURSES, by SUNDAY Sept. 15**

ENTER ON THE DAY FROM 9:00 to 10:30 AM

START TIMES: From 9.30 am
Expect to see start times in Eventor by Tuesday 17th.
EOD courses start after all championship courses (approx. 10:30).

COURSES CLOSE: 1:00 pm. You need to be back at the assembly area by this time, whether or not you complete the course.

DIRECTIONS: Driving directions are in the Eventor page.
Watch for changes to vehicle access if there is wet weather.
The arena and parking are adjacent.
There is an 800 m walk to the Start, with 45 m gradual climb.

* M/W10 Novice is not a standard championship class; entrants may start any time after W10 and M10 starts and may be shadowed but the follower must finish their own course beforehand.

MAP NOTES:

- The area was first mapped by Eric Andrews in 1993. It was remapped to current IOF standards in 2023-24 by Noel Schoknecht. There will be a display copy (without some very recent updates) at the arena.
- All courses have a scale of 1:10,000 and 5m contours.
- Maps will be printed on Pretex (waterproof, tear resistant) paper.
- The forest is predominantly sparse York gums, with extensive open areas and little undergrowth. Forest boundaries are not reliable as “handrails”.
- Animal tracks are not mapped. The visibility of vehicle tracks will depend on grass growth and grazing.
- Recent earthworks around a dam near the Finish have not been mapped.

COURSE NOTES:

- Courses 10 and 11 are bounded on three sides by fences. For safety, competitors on these courses must not cross any fences (ignore marked crossings).
- Three prepared fence crossings will be shown on the maps. These are optional.
- Courses 10 and 11 will have English control descriptions. Course 9 will have both English and IOF symbols on the map and separate lists available at the start.
- Course 10 competitors might encounter taping mid-way around their course. This is not relevant to course 10.
- SI AIR will NOT be active.

START PROCEDURE:

There will be a 3-minute pre-start sequence (see separate document). Check in at the rear of the Start grid 3 minutes before your start time. It is 100 m from the pre-start to the Start marker.

The **EOD Start** is at Registration

FINISH:

The finish is adjacent to the arena.

WATER on COURSES:

Water (for drinking only) will be at controls, to the minimum OFA requirement, and at the Start. You are advised to carry some, especially if it's a hot day.

PRESENTATIONS:

Presentations will take place as soon as practical after 12:30.
