


Anderson's Creek, an area of extensive gravel pit terrain with some sluicing features, adjacent to fast and open spur gully.

Wehla Hill, a satellite block of Mt Kooyoora, but the same dramatic granite but featuring more open terrain.

Mt Korong – a doubling of the terrain area, transforming the map into a wonderful, open granite Long Distance venue.

Please enter using Eventor. From the calendar, tick the boxes for all events that you are entering. This allows you to enter and pay in a single transaction, for yourself and family members. You also select the Easter 3 Day events at the same time, and enter/pay for up to 7 events in one go.

The standard family cap of two adults and one junior will be applied automatically for families with more than one junior.

Late entry fees apply. No entries will be accepted after the final deadline.

It is a condition of entry to all Victorian events that you provide your name and contact phone number, and an emergency contact phone number. Please ensure your entry includes this.




