There is some scratchy undergrowth amongst the boulders so full body cover is recommended for the harder courses.

Directions: From **Toowoomba and Warwick**, head south on the New England Highway and just after passing the Warwick hospital and crossing the railway line, turn right into Glen Road. Follow for 6.1km where the name changes to Washpool Road. Continue straight ahead and 800m past the junction with Ford Road turn left into a property gate flanked by timber rails at 463 Washpool Road. Park as directed. Allow 15 mins travel time from Warwick.

From **Stanthorpe**, head north on the New England Highway and just before crossing the railway line near the hospital, turn left inro Glen Road and follow the directions as above. Allow 55 mins travel time from Stanthorpe.
