

Anzac Weekend – Entry on the Day (EOD) Information

EOD classes are Non Championship and there are no prizes.

Please enter and pay at the Information desk, within the designated entry time frame.

Go to the Start within the designated start time frame. Tell the start official you are entering on the day, and follow their instructions. You will start your course using a start punch.

After completing your course, go to the Download desk and follow instructions. You will receive a splits printout, and your results will appear on Eventor. You MUST return to the finish before course closure time, even if you did not complete your course.

Entry on the Day is only available on the courses listed below.

Entry fees per event:

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| • Adult members of orienteering clubs | \$25 |
| • Junior members of orienteering clubs | \$12 |
| • Adult non-club members | \$30 |
| • Junior non-club members | \$17 |

If you need to borrow a Sportident stick, please ask when entering. There is no charge, but a \$60 fee if the stick is damaged or not returned.

25 April - Victorian Short Distance Championships

No entry on the day is available for this event.

26 April – Victorian Middle Distance Championships. Please pay by cash.

Enter between 10.45am and 11.15am. Start between 11.40am and 12pm.

- EOD Hard – course 3 (3.5 km), go to Start 1 (650m from the arena)
- EOD Moderate – course 7 (2.5 km), go to Start 2 (200m from the arena)
- EOD Easy – course 8 (1.8 km), go to Start 2 (200m from the arena)

27 April – Victorian Long Distance Championships. Please pay by cash or card.

Enter between 10.00am and 10.30am. Start between 11.00am and 11.20am.

- EOD Hard – course 5 (5.1 km)
- EOD Moderate – course 10 (3.7 km)
- EOD Easy – course 11 (2.5 km)
