Location & Access

34 Mahers Rd Martinsville NSW 2265 (Google Maps link)

Property is 40 acres, with 15 acres cleared.

Driving Times: 20 minutes to/from the Arena

We have chosen a camping area this time that is a little slopey, as it is dry and hard and has the best access. You should still be able to find a flattish spot for your tents.

Please take it easy on Martinsville Road especially at dusk and night as kangaroos are very common. Also note that the camping spot is different to the one we used for the 5-days, please see the overview map below.

Registration

The camping is free, noting that there will be no portaloo and a small walk to the toilet at the house.

Power

There will be no official power at the camp site, however all campers will have access to power to recharge phones and other batteries in the Laundry of the house, a short walk from the campsite.

The camp site is north facing, so you will have plenty of sun if you have solar panels.

Water

There will be no water at the campsite, but there will be tank water available on tap at the house, a short walk from the campsite.

Shower

Campers are welcome to use the shower in the house. Please enter through the laundry as per the map and bring your own towel.

Toilets

There will be NO portaloos provided. You are welcome to use the toilet in the main house as per the map below.

In the event of light rain there should be no problems with access or the campsite.

In the event of heavy rain, the grass becomes difficult to drive on. We can assist to extract 2WD cars with a tractor if required if gets really bad.

Dogs are welcome but they must be tied up the whole time and please clean up any mess. We have several kangaroo families that live on our property and we don't want them chased away.

We can supply firewood and you are welcome to have a campfire.
