COURSE NOTES:

MAP: The scale for all courses is 1:10,000. The contour interval is 5m. Standard A4 100gsm paper will be used for all classes. Legend, scale, and control descriptions are provided on the map. Please note that 'control 127' on the map matches 'control 27' on the provided descriptions, '128' and '28' etc.

START & FINISH: The Start and Finish are at the same spot adjacent to the arena. There is no manual punching start SI brick, and there will be several finish punching SI bricks. The finishing order will be determined by who can punch the finish brick first; there is no finish line to cross in Scatter Courses. There will be a beginner briefing at 4:50 PM and a main briefing at 4:55 PM. The start procedure will be a mass start at 5:00 PM; as this event is a scattered course, competitors must choose the minimum number of controls required to complete their registered course. Presentations are at 6:00 PM and may start earlier if all competitors have finished their courses.



COURSE INFORMATION: This Bull Creek MetroO event starts on the southern side of the tennis courts at Oberthur Primary School. Leach Highway provides a northern boundary, Karel Avenue an eastern boundary, Kwinana Freeway a western boundary and whilst there is no major road on the map for the south, South Street is located approximately 300m to the south. The map contains multiple schools as well as a fenced playground, BMX track and cricket ground. These are mostly marked with purple hashing so please stay out of these areas. There is a runnable area along the eastern side of Oberthur Primary School that may be used. There are also a few bushland areas which whilst not all marked out of bounds, it would not be recommended for you to run through. As always make sure to look out for cars and to give way to other pedestrians. Water fountains and toilets will be in the school near the assembly area.

PARKING: Parking will be along Oberthur Crescent alongside the school. There is also additional parking along Nicholls Crescent and in the parking lots on the north side of the school. When walking to the start, please do not go through the school and instead walk around.

DO REMEMBER WATER, SUNSCREEN AND A HAT – IT CAN STILL BE HOT OUT ON THE COURSE AT THAT TIME.
