

welcome all orienteers to Merridee,

Saturday 11th June, for the first of three events in a sublime long weekend of mallee-scrub orienteering!

Start times are available between 12:30 and 2pm; allow 3 hours' driving time from Adelaide GPO.

Signs will be placed from Hallett, 30km north of Burra, after 10am Saturday 10th. Head northeast from Hallett on Scrub Rd for about 22km, passing the T-junction with Banbury Rd at 15km, then 7km later (after crossing a big creek) look for orienteering signs on your left into the scrub. The 400m into the campground is accessible by careful driving for even 2-wheel drives with low clearance.
