5. About This Event:

This is the seventh event in the Statewide OST Series. Because we are starting outside the Devonport Aquatic Centre on the southern end of the Tiagarra map we have access to extensive bushland. Courses are generally close to full lengths with Course 1 just over 9 km. Terrain in the southern end is mixed bushland, some open, some dense with a network of tracks – the map dissected in places by the Don River Railway.

The centre of the map passes the Don College grounds while the north of the map offers some running legs for longer courses. All in all a good mix of bush, parkland and some buildings with some tricky controls and legs.

6. Where Is The Start Area?

Start area is on the eastern edge of the Aquatic Centre car park – actually using the adjacent dog walkers car park. This can be reached by travelling west along Steele St from central Devonport or by taking the Don turnoff from the Bass Highway and heading along Don River Rd to Steele St.

7. When Are Start Times?

Starts between 12.30 pm and 1.30 pm – course closure at 3.00 pm

9. Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.
