Out of Bounds

There will be various areas near the assembly area, on the way to the start and out on course that are out of bounds. Please take care to avoid all such areas.

Some areas will be taped. There will also be some cones placed to remind of out of bound areas.

Please take the time to familiarise yourself with out of bounds and forbidden to cross features in accordance with ISSOM2007. Refer to the end of this document.

Warm Up Area

Northern end of oval east of assembly area and on way to start.

Map Collection

There will be NO map collection at the finish area.

It is the responsibility of finished competitors not to show competitors waiting for their course.

It is the responsibility of waiting competitors not to look at maps from finished competitors.

M/W 10 N - Shadowing

Shadowing is allowed for all competitors in the M/W 10N class. Start times are any time after 10:50am (after the last M10A athlete has started). Report to the start officials when ready to start to be allocated a start time.

Everyone going out on course to shadow must have completed their own course first.

Start Instructions

The start is a walk approximately 250m from the assembly area. Please follow the signs to the start area avoiding any out of bounds areas.

There will be no water provided on course or at the start.

Competitors are to report to the start official three minutes before their allotted start time.

Start time minus three minutes

- -Roll Call
- -Clear & Check

Start time minus two minutes

-Proceed to table with control descriptions

Start time minus one minute

-Proceed to map box containing correct course for class

Start time

- Take map without looking at it
- Punch start
- Proceed to start triangle marked with a flag. There is no punch at the start triangle.

Anyone late to arrive at the start will be reassigned a start time at the end of their course allocated times without penalty.
