Peter Murrell Reserve, Burwood Drive, Blackmans Bay

Sunday 17th July, 2016

Southern Region

4. Event Series Information:

Southern Sunday Local

5. About This Event:

The event is in the Peter Murrell Reserve located on the southern end of Kingston and is bordered by Howden, Blackmans Bay and Huntingfield. The area has lots of tracks making for interesting route choices particularly on parts of the long course. Most of the off-track areas have thick undergrowth making off track excursions hard work in places.

6. Where Is The Start Area?

The start area is located in Blackmans Bay off Burwood Drive. Head south on the Southern Outlet continuing to the roundabout at the Clennetts Mitre 10 Fork in the Road. Take the 2nd exit to Blackmans Bay and onto Algona Road. Follow Algona Road for approx. 3 km to end and turn right at the roundabout into Roslyn Avenue. Follow Roslyn Avenue for approx. 1km and turn right just after the next roundabout into Brightwater Road and head towards Howden. Turn Right again into Burwood Drive, approx. 600m. Turn left onto the track located 500m along Burwood Drive into the Reserve and follow it down to the car park and assembly area.



7. When Are Start Times?

Starts anytime from 10-12. Course closure is 2.00 pm

8. What Are The Courses?

There will be 4 courses :

Novice 2km: very easy navigation

Short 2.6km: easy navigation

Medium 4.2km: medium navigation

Long 5.7km: medium navigation

9. Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or

a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.
