Format: Mass start hagabycourse 1 & 2. Normal start for course 3-5

Map: Diamond Hill North 1:10,000

Terrain Notes: Diamond Hill North is a area close to Bendigo. It provides a good variety of challenge between open fast spur gully running and small details of gold mining. It is a very enjoyable place to run and is often the place for many high quality events in the Bendigo event calendar.

Courses: The standard 5 Bendigo courses will be on offer with approximate distances in the table below.

Courses	Navigation Difficulty	Approximate Distance	Estimated Winning Time
1	Hard	8.5km	55 - 65min
2	Hard	5 - 5.5km	40 - 50min
3	Hard	3.5 - 4km	35 - 40min
4	Moderate	3km	30 min
5	Easy	2km	20 min

Start Time: The sun is due to set at 5:31pm so this dictates the start.

Mass start for course 1 and 2 will be at 5:35pm with a briefing at 5:25pm

Course 3 to 5 must start between 4:50pm and 5:30pm

Entries: Pre Entry is required through Eventor for Course 1 & 2. Courses 3 to 5 are strongly encouraged to pre enter as well. You will get a discount off normal fees if this is done.

Normal **entries close Wednesday 27th of July** at midnight on Eventor. Late entries open until the day before the event and all fees must be paid when you pre enter. No payment, No map!

Note: Normal Bendigo fees do not apply for this event. Entry on the day people will not be guaranteed a map.

Punching system: Sportident - SI chips can be rented.

Spectators: The event will be spectator friendly with the loops coming back through the arena and there will be campfires again. Extra technology may be used too such as O-lynx radio control and results system along with live GPS tracking and the possibility of video. So if you aren't going to run or are running a short course come along and enjoy the atmosphere.

Notes: All competitors participate at own risk and are required to comply with Bendigo Orienteers Safety Regulations.

Live GPS tracking: Living it live is going to be using this event as a trial for a tracking system called Livelox. This system allows anyone with a iOS or Android smartphone to be tracked live through the app. So all that a competitor needs to do is download the app, sign in with your eventor sign in and join the event.
