



Mountain Bike Orienteering Event

This is a 'Come and Try It' event to start the year off by giving those new to MTB Orienteering, an opportunity to have a go in a bush setting. Only basic map reading and navigation skills are required and we'll show you how to do that.

Venue: Murrenbong is an area of open native eucalypt forest with a network of gravel roads and rough bush single track.

Courses: There will be 3 courses to suit all levels of fitness and abilities.
Course 1 9km For riders with some off road riding skills
Course 2 4km For beginners and families
Course 3 60 min Points Score using all controls for teams and families

Equipment: A suitable mountain bike, helmet and water are the basic requirements for this event. A handlebar mounted mapboard that rotates is the best way to hold the map. There are commercially available ones or make you own.
