## Conditions Apply. You must:

- Be a financial 2017 member. New memberships for 2017 may be purchased through Eventor.
- Have your own SportIdent stick (commonly known as E-stick or finger dibber) These sticks may be purchased via office@act.orienteering.asn.au or at any event (at the Information Desk)


## Discounts are available for:

- Seniors and Concession Card holders - \$30 off. Apply using the Services function.


## How to enter

- Please enter via the Eventor website.
- Or you may purchase with Cash, EFTPOS, or Credit Card at most events, but there may be delays and you will need to complete a paper form.


## Notes

The 2017 Saturday series starts in May 2017 and extends through to September 2017. It does not include the National Orienteering League event on Saturday 26 August. There is no refund in the unlikely case that an event is cancelled. You should volunteer to assist your club when it is organizing a Saturday event.

Seniors/Concession Card discount. Seniors Card/Concession holders may obtain a discount of $\$ 30$ through the Services function. To obtain the discount Seniors Card holders should 'Add' the Service 'Seniors/Concession Card Discount' to their order before payment is made. Add only ONE service so you pay $\$ 70$ (Scroll or click box just below Available Services)

Family Discount. A Family Discount is applied automatically when three or more competitors apply for a Season Pass at the same time. The Family Discount will automatically apply according to the algorithm set out in the examples below. The discounts will be applied to any entry of three or more entries comprised of: - at least one adult (aged 21 and above), but no more than two adults (it doesn't prevent application to groups with more adults, it just ignores the other adults for the discount), and

- at least one child (aged 20 and below)

Family Discount Examples. A family will pay for the three most expensive entries only (as defined by the event entry fees); see examples below:

1. Example 1: 2 adults, 1 or more juniors. Entry will be charged for 2 adults and 1 junior. $\$ 270$
2. Example 2: 1 adult, 2 or more juniors. Entry will be charged for 1 adult and 2 juniors. $\$ 240$.
3. Example 3: 2 adults, 1 more adult, 2 or more children. $\$ 270$ for family discount $+\$ 100$ for the extra adult $\$ 370$ total.
