WROC on in and around the gullies and lower slopes of the Meehan Range Nature Recreation Area close to Hobart.

6. Where Is The Start Area?

From Hobart the Tasman Highway toward Hobart Airport. Take the Richmond/Cambridge exit just after the Tunnel Hill cutting. As soon as you exit the Tasman Highway turn left into Belbins Road. Follow for 300 m to the gate. Pass through the gate, making sure to keep it closed, and follow it for 200m to the open area to parking.
