

- Date:** Sunday, April 9th, 2017
- Venue:** Seven Mile Beach.
- Map:** Seven Mile Beach (new map), map scale 1:5 000, contour interval 2 metres
- Mapping:** Mike Morffew, Mark Hey, 2017
- Start Location:** Day use area 1, Surf Road, Seven Mile Beach
- Directions:** **From Hobart area (option 1):** take the Tasman Highway to Cambridge. At Cambridge, take the Seven Mile Beach exit and follow Acton Road for approximately 2.2 km to the Estate Drive roundabout. Follow Estate Drive (first exit) for 2 km to the T intersection at Seven Mile Beach Road. Turn left at Seven Mile Beach Road and follow Seven Mile Beach Road for 1.2 km to The Esplanade. Turn left at The Esplanade and follow The Esplanade for approximately 250 metres to Lewis Avenue, then follow Lewis Avenue for approximately 100 metres to Surf Road. Turn right into Surf Road. The event arena is approximately 900 metres along Surf Road on the beach side of Surf Road.
- Option 2:** take the Tasman Highway to Hobart Airport, then follow Holyman Avenue for approximately 1.2 km to the new Seven Mile Beach access road and follow the Seven Mile Beach road for approximately 2 km to Surf Road. Turn right into Surf Road. The event arena is approximately 600 metres along Surf Road.
- From Launceston:** either take the Midlands Highway to Hobart and follow the directions above, or take the Mud Walls Road (B31) from the Midlands Highway at Jericho to Richmond, then the Richmond Road to Cambridge and follow either of the options above.
- From the Sorell area:** take the Tasman Highway towards the airport, and turn left at Pittwater Road near the Tasmania Golf Club. Follow Pittwater Road to Surf Road (approximately 3.5 km), turn right at Surf Road and follow Surf Road for approximately 2.2 km to the event arena.
- Courses:** Michael Dowling
- Controller:** Greg Hawthorne
- Start Times:** From 10am for School Championships competitors; pre-entry is required, and start times will be allocated. For all others, enter on the day, and start after all school competitors.
- Courses will close at 2.00 pm. The start list will be posted on the Orienteering Tasmania website www.tasorienteeing.asn.au on Friday 7th April. It is your responsibility to be at the start at least 4 minutes before your published start time.

The start will be at the assembly area.

SportIdent timing will be used. Please indicate on your entry whether you need a SportIdent card (SportIdent cards will be provided without charge if necessary).

Important Information

1. Courses 1-4 will have double-sided maps.
2. Course 1 (Boys Open and Boys 16) has 22 controls, so competitors will need SI cards with adequate capacity for this course. Organisers will provide competitors who entered with P-cards with cards for this competition.
3. Competitors who do not have their own SI cards should collect cards (dibbers) from the information tent prior to the competition.
