Cherrabah Resort, south east of Warwick

Terrain: Undulating semi-open to open grazing land with areas of open forest; scattered granite

Map: *Cherrabah North*; 2015; 1:10,000; 5m contour interval

Courses: Hard 1 – 6.1km, Hard 2 – 4.4km; Hard 3 – 3.3km; Moderate 1- 4.2km; Moderate 2 - 3.1km; Easy – 2.4km; Very Easy – 1.9km

Entries: Enter online via Eventor by **Wednesday 17 May** to ensure enough maps are available.

Directions: From Warwick, follow the Killarney signs from the traffic lights at the intersection of Albion (Cunningham H'way) and Wood Streets and follow through to the saleyards. From here, proceed 10km towards Killarney and take the signposted road on the right towards Cherrabah. Proceed 10km down this road before turning right at Elbow Valley into O'Dea's Road and following signs to Cherrabah after turning left into Keogh Road. After entering Cherrabah follow road up the hill towards the resort before turning right at the stables and following track over the dam wall to the assembly area. Allow 30 mins from Warwick.

From Stanthorpe, either take the New England H'way to Warwick and turn right at Bracker Road on the southern outskirts of the town and follow through to the roundabout near the saleyards and then follow the directions towards Killarney as above. Alternatively, take the Old Warwick Rd from Dalveen and follow 19km through to O'Dea's Road. Turn right and follow for 4km to right hand turn into Keogh's Road to Cherrabah. Allow 45 mins from Stanthorpe.
